

Using Kindle Fire for eBooks and eAudiobooks

Kindle Fire users can use the OverDrive Media Console to download Adobe EPUB eBooks and MP3 Audiobooks from the Toronto Public Library directly to their device while connected to a wireless network. Complete these steps to begin enjoying TPL materials on your Kindle today.




Get the OverDrive App

1. Select the **Apps** icon on the Home Screen and select **Store**. Enter **Overdrive Media Console** in the search box and tap **Search**.
2. On the results page, tap OverDrive Media Console. Tap **Free** and **Get App** to begin your download.
3. When the download completes tap **Open**.

Authorize your device

Before using the app, you must first authorize your device with an Adobe ID.

1. Select the **Settings** icon on the Bookshelf bar at the top of the screen:



4. If you already have an Adobe ID, enter your ID and password and select **Authorize**.
5. If you do not have an Adobe ID, select the button to get a free ID on the Adobe website. Alternatively, you can apply for one online at:

Find and download eBooks and eAudiobooks

To begin using the app, configure it to connect to Toronto Public Library's mobile OverDrive site.

1. Open the app on your Kindle and from the Bookshelf bar at top of the screen select **Get Books**.



2. Select **Add a Library**. Search for the Toronto Public Library and add it by selecting any of the branches shown in the results. Select the star to save it to your list of favourites.
3. Select the library name and you will be transferred to TPL's OverDrive mobile site.
4. Browse or search for titles using the buttons on the top of the screen.

**Note: Only formats compatible with your device will be displayed.*

5. When you have found a title you want, select **Borrow**. If the title is unavailable you may request it by selecting **Place a Hold**.
6. Enter your library card and PIN (last 4 digits of your phone number) to sign in. This will take you to the **Bookshelf** section of your account.
7. eBooks can be borrowed for 7, 14, or 21 days. The default loan period is 21 days but can be changed by choosing Settings in the right-hand menu.
8. You can now download the title using the **Download** button beside the item. Select the icon on the top right of the Bookshelf bar to return to your list of books and begin reading.

eBooks will automatically expire at the end of the lending period but can be returned early

Using the OverDrive app, you can return eBooks early on your device. Select the **+** sign beside the title and choose **Return/Delete**.

eBooks and eAudiobooks cannot be renewed
