

# Using Kobo Arc or Vox for eBooks and eAudiobooks

If you have a new device, follow the setup instructions included with your Kobo before getting started.

## Check Device Settings

1. Start your Kobo and select the **Home** icon. Touch **All Apps** then **Settings**, then **Wireless and Networks**.
2. Select the checkbox to turn on Wi-Fi and choose an available network. Also, ensure your device has the correct time zone (GMT-5:00) in the date and time settings on your Kobo.

## Add a Google Account to Your Device

*\*If you have already downloaded apps from the Google Play Store you can skip this step.*

1. Open the Google Play Store app. You will be prompted to Add a Google Account. Follow the instructions which will walk you through signing into an existing Google account or creating a new one.

## Download and Install the OverDrive App

The OverDrive app is available from the Google Play store, or through a link from the OverDrive site [app.overdrive.com/](http://app.overdrive.com/).

## Create an OverDrive Account

You will be required to sign in or sign up for a free [OverDrive account](#) when you install the app. When you create an account, it will automatically authorize your device so you can start reading eBooks right away.

## Add Toronto Public Library

When you open the OverDrive app for the first time you will need to add Toronto Public Library in order to download eBooks.

1. Select the **Menu** icon. Search for **Toronto Public Library** and add any branch displayed in the results. Tap the star to save it.

## Find and Download eBooks and eAudiobooks

1. Select Toronto Public Library to be taken to TPL's OverDrive mobile site.

2. You can search for titles, authors, or subjects by entering keywords in the OverDrive search bar, or you can browse using the menu at the top of the screen. eBook titles are identified by this symbol



on the top right-hand corner of the cover.

Click on the cover to see available formats (PDF or ePUB).

The Kobo also supports e-audio downloads.



Audiobook titles are identified with this symbol on the top right-hand corner of the cover.

3. When you have found a title you want, select **Borrow**. If the title is already checked out, you may request it by selecting **Place a Hold**.
4. Enter your library card and PIN (last 4 digits of your phone number) to sign in. This will take you to the **Bookshelf** section of your account.
4. eBooks and eAudiobooks can be borrowed for 7, 14, or 21 days. The default loan period is 21 days but can be changed by choosing **Settings** in the right-hand menu.
5. You can now download the title by selecting the **Download** button beside the item. The OverDrive app will automatically open the title.

### **eBooks will automatically expire at the end of the lending period but can be returned early**

From your Bookshelf in the OverDrive app on your device, tap and hold the cover of the book. **Delete** will remove the title from your device but keep it on your Bookshelf to download again before the expiry date. **Return** will remove the title from your device and your Bookshelf.

### **eBooks cannot be renewed EPUB and PDF eBooks are supported on the Kobo Arc and Vox**
