



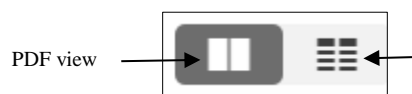
PressReader provides access to newspapers and magazines from over 100 countries in over 60 languages.

Create a PressReader Account:

1. Go to tpl.ca/pressreader and click on **Access Online**. Sign in using your 14-digit library card number and PIN. Click on **Continue**.
2. Close the PressReader HotSpot pop-up message by clicking on the x in the upper left hand corner.
3. Select **Sign In** in the upper right of the page. Click on **New User? Sign up now** to sign up with an email address and password. Please note you cannot create an account using any other method.
4. PressReader [Terms of Use](#) and [Privacy Policy](#) are available for you to read. Click **Done**.

Read in a browser on a desktop computer:

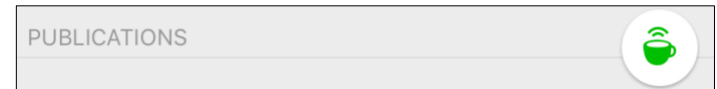
1. Go to tpl.ca/pressreader. Click on **Access Online** and enter your valid Toronto Public Library card number and PIN. Click on **Continue**.
2. Close the HotSpot pop-up and then **Sign In** to *PressReader* using your previously created PressReader account. Your name should display at the top right instead of the words Sign In.
3. Search collections or browse by country, language, category, or publication type.
4. Choose a publication to begin reading.
5. Use the toolbar at the bottom left corner of the screen to switch between PDF view and Text view. Use arrows to move between the pages.



Using the PressReader App on tablet or smartphone

1. Go to Apple's App Store or Google's Play Store to install the free *PressReader* app. Open the app, click on **Accounts**. **Sign In** using your previously created PressReader account.

2. Open a browser and go to tpl.ca/pressreader and sign in with your library card to get complimentary access for a limited time (1 day and 23 hours). Once the complimentary access has expired, log back in to tpl.ca/pressreader through your device's browser to begin another session.
3. Return to the PressReader app and click on the **Publications** tab and look for the green tea cup which indicates that you are signed into complementary access.



4. Search collections or browse by country, language, category, or publication type.
5. Tap on the publication image to select it. Tap on **Open** to start reading and to start the downloading process. Previously downloaded publications can be found in the **Downloaded** section of the app.



6. Use the toolbar at the bottom of the screen to switch between PDF view and Text view.
7. To change font size, tap on **⋮** in the upper right hand corner and select **Font Size** from the menu.
8. Swipe from right to left to change pages.
9. Tap in the centre of the screen and click on the back arrow to exit the publication.

Most publications will remain in your collection indefinitely if you have not chosen a specific auto-removal option through PressReader's settings.

A small number of publishers have placed offline storage restrictions on specific publications. These will be automatically removed from your library after a period of time.
