- Get a **FREE library card**. All you need is two pieces of identification, one with your name and address in Toronto.
- Use a **computer** with Internet access, Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint) and many databases.
- Connect to **free wifi** at all library branches.
- Borrow **books, movies, and more** either in-person at a branch or online. Library materials are available in Ukrainian, Russian and many other languages.
- Meet one-on-one with a **settlement worker** who can help you find a job, get a driver's license and more.
- Borrow **English as a Second Language materials** for adults and children.
- Attend **programs** in-person or online on a variety of topics, including learning English, starting a small business, storytimes for children, and job searching.
